2. Continue as a guest and enter required fields.

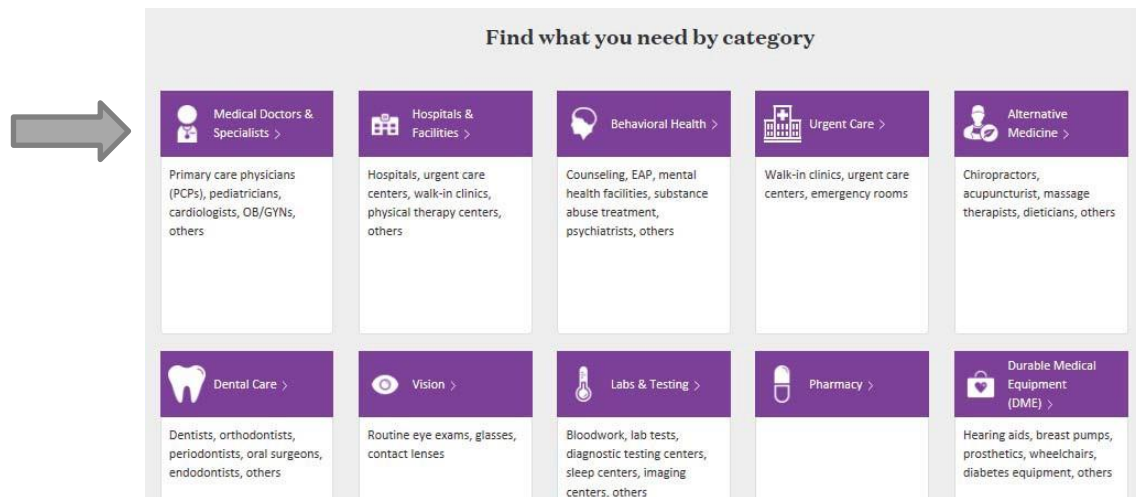

4. Then select "HMO"

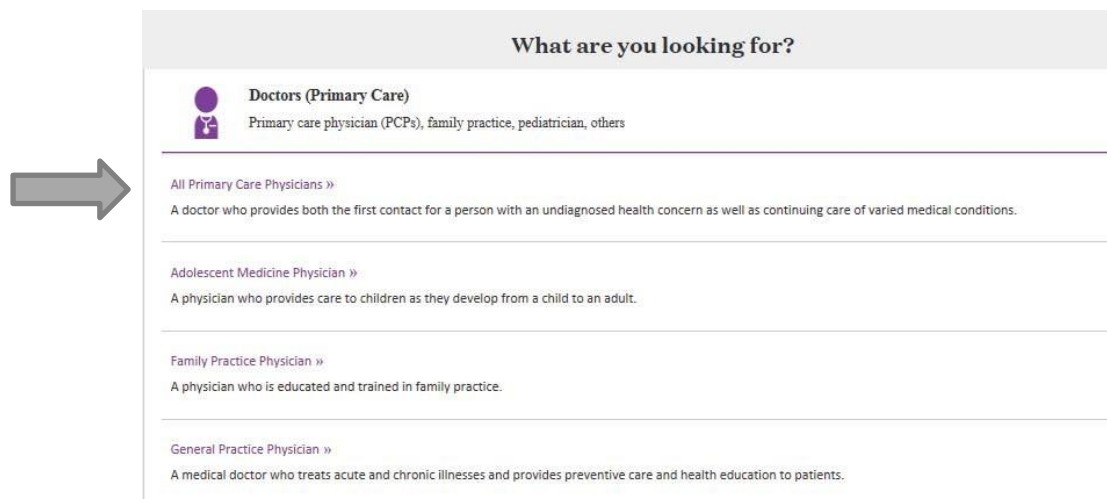
